ACHIEVEMENTS ARE THINGS THAT YOU HAVE DONE THAT YOU FEEL PROUD OF.



I feel proud when I remember . . . That I helped my friend prepare for an exam.


The best thing I ever did was . . . When I helped someone who was badly injured.
